

## Measure 4: Ability of Completers to be Hired

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<b>Overview</b>	This evidence packet contains evidence of EPP completers earning education-related positions or graduate school admission. Confirmation evidence is provided by completers, typically through email communication.

<b>Trends</b>	<p><b>2020-2021 EPP Disaggregated Employment Rates Strengths:</b></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• 100% (25/25) of completers secured an education-related position or graduate school admission</li> </ul> <p><b>2020-2021 EPP Disaggregated Employment Rates Areas of Challenge:</b></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• 8% (2/25) of completers seeking to complete their licensure are working to complete the final content test though earned education positions</li> </ul> <p><b>2018-2019, 2019-2020, and 2020-2021 EPP Disaggregated Employment Rates Trends:</b></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Over 3 cycles, 100% of completers (54/54) secured education-related positions or graduate school admission</li> </ul>
<b>Future Direction</b>	The EPP has established consistent cycles of high employment rates. The EPP dean, faculty, content advisor committee, and stakeholder committee continue to analyze content and pedagogy test performance, which is needed for licensure. In the summer of 2021, the State changed content and pedagogy test companies. The EPP will evaluate how the testing change impacts completer performance. In time, the EPP believes this data, which will be shared with future teacher candidate test-takers, can improve test-taking preparation and therefore, results.
